- Annual Financial Review was conducted in July 2023 for the 2022-23 year. If you see slides, it was circled that PTA did not pay Council dues; Jenn confirmed that the council dues were actually paid.
 - We currently have 25 stale checks that date back as early as 2011, Jenn will work to cancel all stale checks over 180 days old.
 - Christina Sawyers from Elite Accounting Services who did our financial reviews had three comments; all of which were addressed by previous treasurer- Jennifer Burke

 - Motion to approve proposed 2023-24 budget passed with 12 votes
